

BOYCOTT PARCC!

All students can refuse PARCC testing this year.

Illinois is 50th out of 50 for state funding. The state has not even provided 100% of so-called foundation-level funding of \$6,119 per student since 2010.

Chicago taxpayers pay into both the state and the city teacher pension funds. But the rest of the state contributes only to the state fund.

Some schools in CPS have sustained three rounds of budget cuts just this year, and millions have been slashed from district-run school budgets since 2013.

Many schools lack librarians, counselors, nurses, up-to-date textbooks or even the most basic supplies like soap and copy paper.

More than $\frac{1}{3}$ of K-3 students in CPS are in homerooms with >29 students.

Every year parents are asked to contribute more to school budgets or their children are told to go without.

The State of Illinois requires districts to administer PARCC in order to hold schools “accountable”.

It is fundamentally unfair to hold under-resourced schools accountable for their students’ performance.

Accountability based on an invalid, unreliable test score is meaningless.
